## **Go Fishing**

It is amazing how fast our fish are growing in just over a year's time. My grandchildren have caught 3" to 5" Bluegills this summer from my paddleboat. There may be larger fish, based on reports.

Under the leadership of **Carla Fowler**, your neighborhood association is working with **Garrett Pond Resources** for the restocking and maintenance of Staghorn Lake.

Last fall we added thousands of 1–2-inch **Brim**, mostly Bluegills to the lake. Bluegills will grow to about 10 inches or less and are considered the top choice among the sunfish family for cooking and taste quality. These fish have already doubled in size since last year.

This Spring 1-2 inch Large-Mouth Bass were added to the lake. They are a fun sport fish and are a predator of the Bluegills. Large-Mouth Bass easily adapt to lakes and ponds and tolerate both hot and cold-water temperatures.

To aid in the growth of the bass population Threadfin Shad were added. Grass Carp were also added which will help keep Staghorn Lake weeds down.

### **Upgrade of the Fishing Dock**

One of the advantages of being a dues paying Staghorn Club Resident, is the opportunity to fish in the crystal clear waters of Staghorn Lake.

The budget approved for 2023 – 2024 contains about half the funds needed to upgrade our fishing dock. The dock is now in terrible shape and is too dangerous for us to fish from because the wooden boards have rotted through. You can see the damage below.

Plans call for an upgrade to the dock materials by replacing the black floating pads, improving the cable material and using a high-grade decking called MoistureShield. This is a solid core decking with an impermeable barrier that fights damage from moisture, rot, insects and other harmful elements. The MoistureShield material will last for many more years than standard decking. The cost is estimated to be \$18,000 in total.
