Young Beavers in Staghorn Lake

Be on the lookout for busy winter neighbors in Staghorn Lake. Beavers come downstream to find new homes in the fall and winter months. I recently saw three very active young beavers near my dock.



I've learned to put chicken wire around my dock because I have large gashes in the wood poles caused by young beavers. They strengthen their teeth by constantly gnawing on wood, which keeps their continuously growing incisors sharp and prevents them from becoming overgrown. Typically, they leave large, pointed stumps after cutting down small trees.

Beaver females have their young or kits in late spring or early summer, with the birthing season typically from April to June. So, it is not unusual to see these young kits in November.
